# 2021 Hepworth Anglers Club Update



The Hepworth Anglers Club thank Kodey Buchanan of the Steeldreams Fishing Club and Tournaments group for donating \$1000 towards the purchase of a flow meter for Dr. James Hamilton. Shown are Kodey (left) presenting Hepworth Club member Bill Nafziger (right) with \$1000. Kodey is a unique innovative fund raiser, creating the Steeldreams Fishing Tournaments and donating the proceeds to local fishery organizations including various charities. Dr. Hamilton is researching the Hepworth Karst Drainage System, that creates Spring Creek and which is recognized as an important natural migratory fish hatchery benefiting the trout/salmon fishery in the Sauble River/ Lake Huron. The flow meter will be used in conjunction with Dr. Hamilton's monitoring stations on Spring Creek and offsite on water flows to various sink holes. all of which will contribute to Spring Creek's important role and continuance of its natural features into the future.

The Spring Creek Restoration Project now in its eighth year, continued with the addition 79 tonnes of angular spawning stone, which was used to create another spawning area and enhance other spawning areas in Spring Creek. 2021 Summer students Julia Elliot (U of Guelph) and Dominic Fleming (Wilfrid Laurier) assisted with Dr. Hamilton's monitoring activities, including working on ongoing Spring Creek maintenance such as cleaning spawning areas, installing/cleaning aeration diffusers, enhancing natural aeration features, performing fish counts, etc.

Again, thank you Kodey ("steeldreams fishing club and tournaments") for your one of a kind efforts, of giving back and benefitting the fisheries/local charities.

## Fish Hatchery

Raising trout has been the big focus of the BPSA since its inception. It is the oldest Community Hatchery in Ontario. We raise about 150,000 rainbow trout and 30,000 brown trout annually to be released in local waters. The hatchery was built by and is operated by club members on a volunteer basis.



Tourism officials recognize that these efforts have been responsible for over \$15 million in economic benefits to the local community.
